4. You will pass a beautiful state park that has camping, hiking trails, a disc golf course, playgrounds, and plenty of picnic spots! It's name is

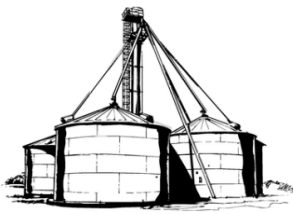
